

AUSTRALIAN RING SIZE CHART

HOW TO MEASURE YOUR RING SIZE

1. Print this document and make sure "page scaling" and 'fit to' options are set correctly. The print setup should be a scaling of 100% or 'actual' size and 'fit to' should be unchecked - dependent on the printer options. Paper selection should be A4.
2. Once printed, measure the scale lines below with a ruler (or place an existing coin on the images) to ensure the document is exactly the scale as required. The scales 100mm or 3 inches are given.
3. Use one of your own rings that comfortably fits the desired finger.
4. Place the ring over the circles below, until you find your size. The measurements below refer to the inside diameter of the ring and the letters to your ring size. When you order your ring, use this as guidance.
5. If your ring falls between two sizes, order the larger size, to be on the safe side.
